HIPPA

The Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPPA) is a federal law enacted by Congress in 1996. The Act required the Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) to issue the rules for the following:

1. Privacy – the patient’s right to keep their health information private
2. Security – the means (process and technology) by which an entity protects electronic health information from tampering, destruction, or inappropriate access.
